

The District would like to provide an important update regarding the remainder of the 2026 irrigation season.

Based on current flows and available water supplies, the Interstate Canal is expected to shut down on August 7. As water levels begin to drop through the system, we encourage all water users to plan accordingly and take the necessary steps to protect their irrigation equipment as flows diminish.

At this time, the Low Line Canal is expected to continue operating through approximately August 14, provided the District can maintain adequate flow out of Lake Minatare as the lake elevation continues to decline during the drawdown. We will continue to closely monitor conditions and will notify users if this schedule changes.

The 2026 irrigation season has been one of the most challenging in the District's history due to the extremely limited water supply. Despite these difficult circumstances, our water users have demonstrated exceptional cooperation, patience, and responsible water management. Your efforts have helped us maximize the limited water available and have been greatly appreciated.

On behalf of the Board of Directors and District staff, thank you for your continued understanding and support throughout this historic season. We remain hopeful that this is a one-year event and look forward to more favorable water conditions in the future.
